Policy Council	Policy Council is the Governing Body of Early Head Start/Head Start comprised of 51% parents and 49% Community Representatives. Policy Council Representatives are elected by their Parent Committee. Each Head Start classroom elects 1 representative and 1 alternate. The Early Head Start program elects 2 Representatives and 2 alternates. Policy Council usually meets the first Wednesday of every month with the exception of July.
